Post-Graduate Research Programme

The one years Post Graduate Research Programme in Human Rights being conducted through online correspondence has been designed for meeting the growing needs of academicians, defenders and scholars in the field of human rights, civil liberties, Peace and conflict resolution, international humanitarian issues, refugee rights and laws, disaster and emergency relief, apartheid and racial discrimination, drug abuse, judicial activism and global and regional perspectives of human rights. The admissions for the one year Post Graduate Research Programme in Human Rights commences every year for March, June, September and December sessions for all such persons who have successfully obtained their Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification in any discipline.

The Post=Graduate Research programme is distinctive focus of the programme is on theoretically informed and multidisciplinary approaches to human rights, duties and responsibilities. It aims to expose you to a advanced, critical and contextual engagement with the subject. You will study human rights in their legal, political, sociological, anthropological and philosophical contexts. Peace, Developmental, Legal, Political, social and economic challenges are frequently articulated through the language of human rights. You will be introduced to a wide variety of approaches to research across a range of disciplines, and to the theoretical frameworks for advanced legal scholarship. You will also take specialist courses, choosing from a wide range of subjects in the area of human rights.

ADMISSION

Entrance Requirements and Admissions

- Applicants must submit online application with all required and supporting documents for consideration.
- Applicants must hold Bachelor degree in any discipline.
- There is no pre-requisite for pursuing a Certificate program.
- Based on the information and credentials, faculty or staff may ask certain candidates to take a competency, entrance or equivalency test to determine their academic standing, depth of knowledge and experience (if they are claiming educational credits based on experience) in their area of interest.
- A personal interview may be required.

Credit for Previous Education, Training and Experience.

- The school accepts transfer credits from other schools after evaluating the content of the courses taken, and may allow credits for courses with similar content and academic goals.
- Students may be asked to take additional courses to make up for any deficiency.
- The school, based on equivalency tests, challenge exams, projects and assignments by the faculty or on faculty's recommendation, may grant credits for certain professional training, trade related, professional or military work experience.
- The school staff to determine credits to be awarded, if any, based on their review of previous education, training and experience.

English Language Requirements:

Applicants students who completed their previous education in mode of English are exempted from English proficiency test i.e. TOEFL and IELTS. The provision applies to the students those native language is not English but their mode of instruction in previous qualification is English.
