



## Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Institute for Asian Crime and Security, USA

And

Yadam Institute of Research, India

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes a type of partnership between the 'Institute for Asian Crime and Security' ('IACS'), a Non-profit Organization/Institution Established in the USA, and 'Yadam Institute of Research' ('YIR'), a Non-Profit Organization/Institution established in India and enters date on the 'Execution Date.'

### I. MISSION

The Parties enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to mutually promote the security and Human Rights, including the rights of vulnerable groups of people, especially women and children, in the region of Asia. Accordingly, the IACS and YIR, operating under this MOU, agree as follows:

### II. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

IACS and YIR aim to create a cluster with governments, civil societies, scholars, researchers, humanitarians, and corporate to address and mitigate the security threats to vulnerable groups of people, especially women and children, in the region of Asia. The issue areas include but are not limited to transnational organized crime, human rights, gender, women and child safety, domestic violence, cybercrime, racial discrimination, health.

### III. PARTNERSHIP GOALS

IACS and YIR shall work within the strategized framework known as Partnership Goals described below:

GOAL-1: Building Cluster with governments, civil societies, scholars, researchers, humanitarians, and corporate. The cluster shall aim to achieve the further goals mentioned below.

GOAL-2: Researching the societal, Regional, National, and transnational organized crime such as human rights violations, All forms of crimes against women and children, gender-related violence, including domestic violence, Social Problems in Asian Countries, and all other forms of crimes those are a



threat to society and humanity. Both the Institutes shall explore all possible conduct research with universities, governments, United Nations bodies, colleges, civil societies, individuals, and corporate sectors.

GOAL-3: Organizing seminars, workshops, symposiums, webinars, workshops, training programs, incubations programs, and conferences.

GOAL-4: Publishing books, journals, videos, documentaries on human rights, violence against women, child and gender, peace and conflict, social problems, and health issues.

GOAL-5: Supporting other action programs such as charity and humanitarian aid to the needy people and community.

#### IV. RESPONSIBILITIES

Each party will appoint a person to serve as the official contact and coordinate the activities of each organization in carrying out this MOU. Both the parties shall meet to review/Amend/Revise MOU annually. Both the parties shall share technical know-how and Action Audit report whenever asked by either party.

#### V. TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

The term of this MOU is for **five years** from the effective date of this agreement. However, it shall be reviewed **annually** to ensure that it is fulfilling its purpose and to make any necessary revisions. Either organization may terminate this MOU upon thirty (30) days' written notice without indemnity.

#### Authorization

The signing of this MOU is not a formal undertaking. It implies that the signatories will strive to reach the best of their ability, the objectives stated in the MOU.
